

Terms of Use for internal and external research groups for the “Vesztergombi Laboratory for High Energy Physics” (VLAB) infrastructure

The VLAB is located at the Wigner Research Centre for Physics (WRCP) Budapest campus, and is a facility for R&D activities around high energy physics instrumentation, as well as related fields. It is owned by WRCP, and managed by the High Energy Physics Department.

The usage of the infrastructure applying to "internal" users, including members of the Wigner RCP, and also the international members of the CERN RD51, CERN ALICE and CERN NA61 collaborations, requires brief description of the proposed activity. In case of considerable cost investment from the side of the VLAB (Wigner RCP), matching cost negotiation will take place.

For all other "external" users, the description of the proposed activity and description of the expected results is to be communicated in a written (e-mail), clearly stating the name and contact of the main proponent, and institute affiliation. In case that the feasibility of the activity is confirmed, a usage cost will apply.

The activities at VLAB may result in the creation of an Intellectual Property (IP), as well as scientific results and public release, therefore the following rules apply:

Declaration of Prior Knowledge:

In case of an existing IP or know-how, which is not related to Wigner RCP, must be declared in writing, before the beginning of the research and development activity or project at VLAB.

Confidentiality:

No participants of the activity are allowed to, before written (e-mail) consent by all participating members, including the management of the relevant external group and the Wigner RCP, to share information about the details of the activity to any third party. Publication and dissemination of the results are strongly encouraged after consent and discussion among the participants.

Identification of Know-how and IP:

In case that a Know-how or IP is created during the activity, the participants must be informed in writing, briefly describing the nature of the invention. In case that the VLAB researchers contributed to the IP, the research activity members will negotiate the joint ownership of the IP.

Exchange of information:

During the research activity at VLAB, all participants are obliged to share all relevant information with each other, which is needed for a safe, efficient and complete realization of the research objectives.
